—Anton Chekhov

About the Author—Anton Chekhov (1810-1904) was born in a middle-class family in Russia. He studied medicine at Moscow University. His first short story appeared in 1880 and, in the next seven years, he produced more than six hundred stories. He also wrote plays—Seagull, Uncle Vanya, The Three Sisters and The Cherry Orchards are among the more famous ones. His work greatly influenced the modern short story and drama.

The main theme of Chekhov's short stories is life's pathos, caused by the inability of human beings to respond to, or even to communicate with, one another. The present story illustrates this point beautifully.

लेखक के बारे में एन्टोन चैखव (1810-1904) का जन्म रूस के एक मध्यमवर्गीय परिवार में हुआ था। उन्होंने मास्को विश्वविद्यालय से चिकित्सा की शिक्षा प्राप्त की। उनकी पहली लघु कहानी 1880 में प्रकाशित हुई और अगले सात वर्षों में, उन्होंने छ: सौ से ज्यादा कहानियाँ लिखीं। उन्होंने नाटक भी लिखे—'सीगुल', 'अंकल वान्या', 'द थ्री सिस्टर्स' और 'द चैरी आरचार्ड्स' उनके प्रसिद्ध नाटक हैं। उनके लेखन ने आधुनिक लघु कहानी और नाटक को अत्यधिक प्रभावित किया।

चेखव की लघु कहानियों की मुख्य विषय–वस्तु मनुष्य के प्रत्युत्तर देने में असमर्थता के कारण जीवन के कष्ट और एक–दूसरे से सम्प्रेषण की कमी के कारण होने वाले जीवन के दु:ख है। प्रस्तुत कहानी इस बिन्दु को शानदार तरीके से प्रस्तुत करती है।

About the Story—The story 'The Lament' by Anton Chekhov is about a Russian Sledge driver who has recently lost his son. The writer presents the story of Iona Potapov who drives his cart and so many people come to him to make them reach their destinations. Each time, Iona tries to make his grief short by sharing with his passengers but all of them have their own problems in life. Thus, Iona is unable to unburdon himself by sharing his grief. He gets no sympathy from anyone. So, he feels lonely and agony of his son's death more painfully. Finally, he turns towards his faithful horse who listens to his sorrows patiently. Thus, Iona finds peace and tranquility. His heart becomes light. He tells the whole story to his horse that was a burden on his mind and relieves himself from the pressure. His misery is relieved through telling the story with 'The Lament'.
